



## Coppermill Sports Premium Spending 2016/2017

### Principles

This additional government funding is to provide opportunities to develop school sport, joint funded by the Department for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport. It can only be spent on Sport and PE provision in schools.

The PE lead and Headteacher has placed a high emphasis on using the funding to improve PE and sport provision throughout the school. The table below shows a breakdown of expenditure for the last academic year.
